

- (HOLD): Used to place a call on hold.
- CANCEL: Used to cancel the selected item.
- INT' (INTERCOM): Used to make or receive intercom calls.
- ④ ♣(SP-PHONE [Speakerphone]): Used for performing hands-free operations.
- **Microphone:** Used for hands free conversations.
- Flexible CO Buttons: Used to seize an outside line or perform a feature that has been assigned to the key.
- NEXT PAGE Key: Used to switch the page for the Self Labelling feature. (KX-NT560 only)

Before Operating the Telephone

Speaker volume

While in a hands-free conversation

Press $[\blacktriangle]$ or $[\nabla]$ to adjust the volume.

Handset/Headset volume*1

While using the handset or headset

Press $[\blacktriangle]$ or $[\nabla]$ to adjust the volume.

Ringer volume

While on-hook or receiving a call Press $[\blacktriangle]$ or $[\nabla]$ to adjust the volume.

LCD Contrast

While on-hook

- 1. Press the **PROG** soft button (S1).
- 2. Enter (0(1).
- 3. Press [ENTER].
- 4. Press $[\blacktriangle]$ or $[\nabla]$ to adjust the LCD contrast.
- 5. Press [ENTER].
- 6. Press [CANCEL].

Ring Tone

- 1. Press the **PROG** soft button (S1).
- 2. Press a flexible CO button or *INT*'[INTERCOM] 2 times.
- 3. Enter 2 digits (01-30) using the dial keys (0-9), or press [▲] or [▼] to select the ring tone.
- 4. Press [ENTER].
- 5. Press [CANCEL].
- *1 If you hear your own voice through the handset or headset, decrease the volume.

LCD Backlight
 While on-hook 1. Press the PROG soft button (S1). 2. Enter (0)(4). 3. Press [ENTER]. 4. Press a dial key to select the LCD backlight mode. (0): Automatic (1): Always ON (2): Always OFF 5. Press [ENTER]. 6. Press [CANCEL]
6. Press [CANCEL]. Registering the Bluetooth [®] headset (KX-NT560 only)
 Set the Bluetooth headset to pairing mode by following the instructions provided with the headset. Press the PROC soft button (S1). Enter (3)(3). Enter (3)(3). Press [ENTER]. Enter the Pass Key and press [ENTER].*1 Press [CANCEL].
Confirming the ID of the Bluetooth headset and deregistering the Bluetooth headset (KX-NT560 only)
 Press the PROG soft button (S1). Enter (37). Press [ENTER].*2*3 Press [ENTER] to deregister the headset. Press [CANCEL].

Feature Operations

Making Calls

Calling

[To an extension]

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Dial an extension number.

[To an outside party]

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Press a flexible CO button.
- 3. Dial the outside party's phone number.

Redial

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Press CO[REDIAL].

Quick Dialling

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Dial a quick dialling number.

Doorphone Call

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Enter (★)③(1).
- 3. Enter a doorphone number (2 digits).
- 4. After the confirmation tone, talk.

System Speed Dialling

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Press $\rightarrow /$ [AUTO DIAL/STORE].
- 3. Enter a system speed dialling number (3 digits).

Personal Speed Dialling

[To store]

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Enter **★**30.
- 3. Enter a personal speed dialling number (2 digits).
- 4. Enter the phone number to store (max. 32 digits).*1
- 5. Press **#**.
- 6. After the confirmation tone, go on-hook.

[To dial]

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Press $\rightarrow / \Rightarrow$ [AUTO DIAL/STORE].
- 3. Enter ↔.
- 4. Enter a personal speed dialling number (2 digits).

One-touch Dialling

[To store]

- 1. Press the **PROG** soft button (S1).
- 2. Press a flexible CO button.
- 3. Enter 2.
- 4. Enter the number to store (max. 32 digits).*1
- 5. Press [ENTER].
- 6. Enter the text to store (max. 12 digits).*2
- 7. Press [ENTER].*2
- 8. Press [CANCEL].

[To dial]

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Press the flexible CO button assigned as a One-touch Dialling button.
- *1 Enter the outside line access number before an outside phone number.
- *2 KX-NT560 only

During a Conversation

Call Hold

[To hold]

- 1. Press **__**[HOLD].
- 2. After the confirmation tone, go on-hook.

[To retrieve a call at the holding extension]

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Press a flexible CO button or *INT*'[INTERCOM].

[To retrieve an outside call from another extension]

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Press a flexible CO button.

Call Transfer

[To an extension]

- 1. Press , [TRANSFER].
- 2. After the confirmation tone, dial an extension number.
- 3. Talk.
- 4. Go on-hook.

[To an outside party]

- 1. Press , [TRANSFER].
- 2. After the confirmation tone, press a flexible CO button.
- 3. Dial an outside phone number.
- 4. Talk.
- 5. Go on-hook.

Setting the Telephone According to Your Needs

Do Not Disturb

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Enter **(★**⑦①.
- 3. Press a dial key to select the setting.
 - (): Both outside and intercom calls
 - 1: Outside calls only
 - 2: Intercom calls only
- 4. To enable Do Not Disturb, enter ①.To cancel Do Not Disturb, enter ③.
- 5. After the confirmation tone, go on-hook.

Timed Reminder

[To set]

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Enter ⊛7601.
- 3. Enter the hour and minute (4 digits).
- 4. If 12-hour-time display is set, enter (1) (AM) or (1) (PM).
- 5. Enter (1 time) or (1 (daily).
- 6. After the confirmation tone, go on-hook.

[To cancel]

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Enter **※**⑦⑥00.
- 3. After the confirmation tone, go on-hook.

[To stop or answer the ring back]

1. Press *INT*'[INTERCOM], or go off-hook.

Useful Features

Multiple Party Conversation

[To add other parties during a conversation]

- 1. Press \triangle [CONF].
- 2. After the confirmation tone, dial the phone number of the party to add.
- 3. Talk to the new party.
- Press ▲[CONF].
- 5. After the confirmation tone, talk with multiple parties.

[To leave a conference]

- 1. Press ☆[CONF].
- 2. After the confirmation tone, go on-hook.


Before Leaving Your Desk

Call Forwarding

- 1. Go off-hook.
- 2. Enter ⊛⑦①.
- 3. Press a dial key to select the types of calls to apply this feature to.(D): Both outside and intercom calls
 - 1: Outside calls only
 - 2: Intercom calls only
- 4. Press a dial key to select the status.
 - 2: All calls
 - 3: Busy
 - (4): No answer
 - (5): Busy/No answer
 - (): Cancel*1
- 5. Enter an extension number, and then enter *(#)*, or enter a CO line access number, an outside phone number, and then enter *(#)*.
- 6. After the confirmation tone, go on-hook.
- *1 If you enter (1) in Step 4, you can skip steps 5 and 6.

Self Labelling (KX-NT560 only)

The KX-NT560 IP-PT features 8 flexible buttons around an LCD screen. Each item can be named on the LCD screen through personal or system programming to reflect the function of its corresponding flexible button. Additionally, the flexible buttons can be organised into 4 "pages", allowing you to assign a total of 32 items to the 8 flexible buttons. You can toggle between pages by pressing the NEXT PAGE key, as follows:



Storing a One-touch Dialling button, and setting the displayed text for the Self Labelling LCD Display

- 1. Press the **PROG** soft button (S1).
- 2. Press a flexible CO button, or press the NEXT PAGE key, and then press a flexible CO button.
- 3. Enter 2.
- 4. Enter the number to store (max. 32 digits).*1
- 5. Press [ENTER].
- 6. Enter the text to store (max. 12 digits).
- 7. Press [ENTER].
- 8. Press [CANCEL].
- *1 Enter the outside line access number before an outside phone number.
